Temporary Structures and Temporary Uses

On Who's Authority? • SECTION 108. TEMPORARY RUC: RES AND USES (Also refer to Section 107 of the CEBC) • 108.1 General. The building official author ed to issue a permit for temporary structures and emporary solve permits shall be limited as to time of service but shall not be mitted for more than 180 days. The building official is authorized to grant externions for demonstrated cause.

The Temporary Structures and Uses Code Application Notice (CAN) 2-108 was updated February 3, 2021. In the video, OSHPD explains how the revised CAN applies and what is required when temporary structures and equipment is needed when it comes to new buildings, additions, and remodel projects.

This weeks SBS LABS section, we want to highlight the importance of Backflow Prevention Devices and Assemblies. This is a specific line item related to OSHPD's TIO found *here* with California Plumbing Code 603.2 & 603.4.2 you can find *here*. Things to have as part of the initial TIO approval/clearing of comments is the certifiers license in the county they are performing the testing in. You can find an example of this and a sample form *here*. We've also included a free copy of Patrick Murray's eBook, "The Importance of Testing Backflows" *here* and Backflow Basics *here*.

It is the responsibility of the IOR to ensure that the firm and licensed individual that is listed on the approved TIO performs testing on all backflow prevention devices and assemblies for the project. The BFPD reports will be completed and submitted to the design professional for review/approval prior to the IOR signing

the TIO and presenting to OSHPD for final acceptance.
